

NEMHA REGISTRATION INFORMATION GUIDE 2024

1. GENERAL INFORMATION UPDATES FROM PREVIOUS YEARS

- North East has the highest ice rental rates in the province. We don't own our own ice surface, we are not subsidized in any way by the Municipalities in the North East Region and therefore, unfortunately, must pass the cost along to the membership.
- There is no more “double carding” this year in the metro region. Double Carding means to be registered for two different teams under HNL. Examples include playing on a minor C or D development team and a minor house league team or playing both a minor mixed team and a female team. As such, the DJHL has introduced a C division this year in which North East will select and enter two teams to play, along with the historical A, and B division teams.

2. LEAGUE PLAY

Divisions and Registration Fees

Each year, the budget is reviewed, and fees are established on the following parameters.

All athletes carry the administrative cost (OH) of the association which includes but is not limited to:

- Staff salaries and contractors
- General office administrative costs (lease, phone, software license etc)
- Bank fee/credit card charges
- Insurance

This OH is calculated and distributed over all members evenly, NE then completes the break down and includes Hockey NL and Hockey Canada Fee and Jersey/socks for a total OH costs.

The next step is to calculate practice hours per division using ice hours, ice costs and arena as hours per arena costs vary from \$185 - \$290 per hour.

Once those calculations are complete, the final step is to determine the games and practice calculations which again use hours, arena costs, number of players per games in addition to timekeepers and official cost.

Every division has a different fee based on the variable used in the calculation. Any division with low numbers calculates to a higher cost per player, for example, selected teams such as all-star teams only have 17 players budgeted on ice for practice whereas house teams are averaged on different numbers based on history.

Play-off series style play-offs = A multiple round play-offs where each round is made up of series in which teams will play more than one game against each other before moving onto the next round. ie. 2 out of 3, 3 out of 5, or first to 4 pts etc. In this style, teams could play upwards of 6-10 more games to determine the championship.

Year end play-off tournament = Single weekend tournament in which teams are usually given one game against different opponents and a single game championship. Teams will usually play maximum of 4 games to determine championship.
