

Female Team Representatives

For the upcoming season, all North East Female teams will be required to have a Hockey NL approved female staff member. This is a Hockey NL requirement, and while it has not been strictly enforced in previous seasons, it will now be a condition that all female teams must meet. Teams will not be granted ice time until this staff member is in place.

Responsibilities

The role includes the following responsibilities:

- Ensure dressing room access is controlled before and after games. Players needing assistance with tightening skates should come outside the dressing room.
- Coordinate with male coaching staff to ensure players are dressed and ready before coaches enter the room to address the team.
- Be present on the bench for all games.
- Provide assistance on the bench with equipment adjustments or assessing injuries.

Requirements

To fulfill this role, you will need to complete the following:

- The Shift Forward (HNL Online Course approx. 90 minutes)
- HNL Screening Application
- Code of Conduct / Background Check

We also recommend completing the Hockey Canada Safety – Level 1 course. While not mandatory, this online course takes approximately 3.5 hours and provides valuable knowledge.

The Association will reimburse the cost of any courses. RNC Background Check fees are waived upon application.
